AWARD CATEGORIES

RISING STAR *(manager members only)*

The Rising Star Award recognizes a manager with less than two years of experience in the California community management industry who has consistently raised the bar and exceeded a board's expectations by solving a challenging situation, gaining confidence of a board or exceeding the board's expectations.

INNOVATOR *(manager members only)*

This award recognizes one manager who uses their unique resources to kick start innovation and solve critical issues or improve association conditions. Managers should show innovative thinking and action in one or several of the following:

- Board Management
- Financial Management
- Community Building
- Out of the box solutions

LEADERSHIP *(manager members only)*

This award recognizes a manager who has fostered another's professional growth. Nominees are known for mentoring and inspiring others, helping define professional goals and supporting the success of their peers.

EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE *(manager or industry partner)*

This award is presented to a member for their contributions to continuing education and professional development and growth of managers. Nominees further CACM's education programs and provide outstanding service to the organization.

COMPANY CULTURE *(manager and industry partner members)*

Businesses work hard to create a culture and identity that's unique. One that helps retain staff, positively impacts the actions and attitudes of their team and fuels growth. Nominees in this category also are involved in community service and social responsibility, as both form part of the overall cultural fabric of the business. This award recognizes all factors that influence company culture.

Submit a narrative detailing the accomplishments and why the individual or company you are nominating deserves to win the award (no more than 700 words). Be as specific as possible. Submit narrative, completed nomination form and headshot to communications@cacm.org. To help ensure impartial judging, please do not reference the nominee's name, identity, association or company in the narrative.

Nominees must be a member in good standing (no outstanding balances, current or pending complaints filed with the Professional Standards Committee).

JUDGING AND CRITERIA

Each nominee will be evaluated by a judging panel made up of previous award winners. Winners will be selected based on accomplishments provided on the submitted narrative.
